The examples below are not exhaustive. Instead they are meant to be a guide towards how to think about the required fields needed in the four general household types:

Scenario 1: Household applying based on assistance program participation

- A household where at least one household member participates in an assistance program, and no children in the household meet the criteria for any status. The required information is the child(ren)'s names, student status, assistance program case number, contact information, and an adult's signature and date.

Scenario 2: Household applying based on income thresholds

- A household that does not participate in an assistance program, where no children in the household meet the criteria for any status. The required information is the children's names, student status, names of all adult household members, household income information, total household size, SSN, contact information, and an adult's signature and date.

Scenario 3: Household applying based on student status of foster, migrant, homeless, runaway, head start

- A household that does not participate in an assistance program, where there are five children, two are a foster children, one is a Head Start participant, one is both a foster and Head Start participant, and one is a confirmed runaway. The required information is the children's names, student status, each child's status as foster/runaway/Head Start (as applicable), contact information, and an adult's signature and date.

Scenario 4: Mixed household applying based on both income thresholds and on student status

- A household that does not participate in an assistance program, where there are three students, one is a foster child, one is a Head Start participant, and one does not meet the criteria for any status. The required information is the children's names, student status, each child's status as foster/Head Start, as applicable, the names of all adult household members, household income information, total household size, SSN, contact information, and an adult's signature and date.

ⁱ Required information is that which the household would need to provide in order to determine eligibility. The way in which the application prompts for this information is up to the designer.

ⁱⁱ Status has been confirmed with school/district liaison.

ⁱⁱⁱ Contact information is not required, but should be prompted for.
